



## **Presidential Envoys Application 2022-2023 Academic Year**

### **About the Presidential Envoys**

The Presidential Envoys are a group of high-achieving students from across the university. These students will assist the Office of the President, the Office of Alumni Engagement and Special Events, and University Advancement in their missions. Benefits include, a Presidential Envoy blazer to use for the duration of your service, the opportunity to shadow President Chris Markwood during their final year, special invitation to exclusive University-wide events, \$50 book scholarship per semester, other Envoy-specific scholarship opportunities, and unparalleled access and interaction with CSU senior leadership, trustees, alumni, and community leaders.

Those selected for the 2021-2022 academic year will be required to attend assigned University functions throughout the academic year. These events include but are not limited to, First Thursdays, CSU Foundation Board of Trustees Meetings, Alumni Association Board of Directors Meetings, Homecoming, our annual scholarship fundraiser, Giving Society Events, Senior Toast, Graduation, Regional Events, President's Receptions, President's Holiday Parties, and WinterFest.

### **Requirements**

To be considered for membership in the Presidential Envoys students must be:

- Regularly enrolled sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student by Fall 2022;
- Taking at least 12 credit hours (9 credits for graduate students) each semester;
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above

### **Time Commitment**

With about 60 events per year between the Office of the President and University Advancement, Presidential Envoys will be required to attend an estimated 5 events per semester, in addition to mandatory events such as the Envoy retreat in the Fall, Faculty & Staff Welcome Back, Graduation, Celebration of Support, and our annual scholarship fundraiser. The length of each event will vary on the assignment. Presidential Envoys will self-select which events they wish to attend. Outside of events, Presidential Envoys will have monthly meetings and other professional development opportunities. Members of the Executive Board may be invited to attend an out of town conference. All requirements are subject to change based on scheduling. This appointment to the Presidential Envoys will be for the 2022-2023 academic year.
